# ARLINGTON COUNTY BOARD

## MATT de FERRANTI

Matt de Ferranti is running for the Arlington County Board because we need a **new vision for Arlington's future**. ### Matt's new vision for Arlington's future starts with growing our economy:

- Promotes Arlington as the intellectual research and development hub for the region by leveraging our greatest resource—our people—and engaging with and convening leaders in the technology, clean energy, and cyber security sectors.
- Works to reduce our commercial vacancy rate by keeping and growing existing businesses and attracting new ones, so that all of us benefit.
- Prioritizes adoption of the next generation of wifi technology to create jobs by attracting high-tech companies and other businesses that use large amounts of data.

### Matt's new vision for Arlington's future includes goals for shared prosperity:

- Supports a fully comparable fourth high school to serve the students who are already enrolled in our schools. We must build the schools we need to educate every child well.
- Pursues creative approaches on cooperative homeownership programs that would help our teachers, first responders, and middle-income Arlingtonians afford to stay in the community that they love and serve.
- Sets a goal of 100% renewable energy in Arlington by 2035 to tackle one of the biggest threats to the prosperity of our future generations.
- Works to end child hunger in Arlington by 2022 by investing in anti-hunger efforts and better coordinating our work to make sure no child goes hungry. We are a compassionate community— we can do this.

### Service to Arlington

Matt helped the School Board reduce a \$20 million budget gap without cutting core educational services as Chair of the Arlington Public Schools Budget Advisory Council this past year. He has been a member of the Arlington County Housing Commission since 2013, serving on the Affordable Housing Working Group. He has also served on the Joint Facilities Advisory Commission, which helps the County, Arlington Public Schools, and the community come together to better plan for our future.

### Professional Experience

Matt grew up locally and began his career as a teacher, which has led to a lifelong commitment to education. He went on to serve as an attorney for cities, working on matters involving land use law. For the past decade, he has worked on hunger, housing, and education issues at national nonprofits, including Feeding America, Habitat for Humanity, Rebuilding Together, and, currently, on educational equity for Native American students.
